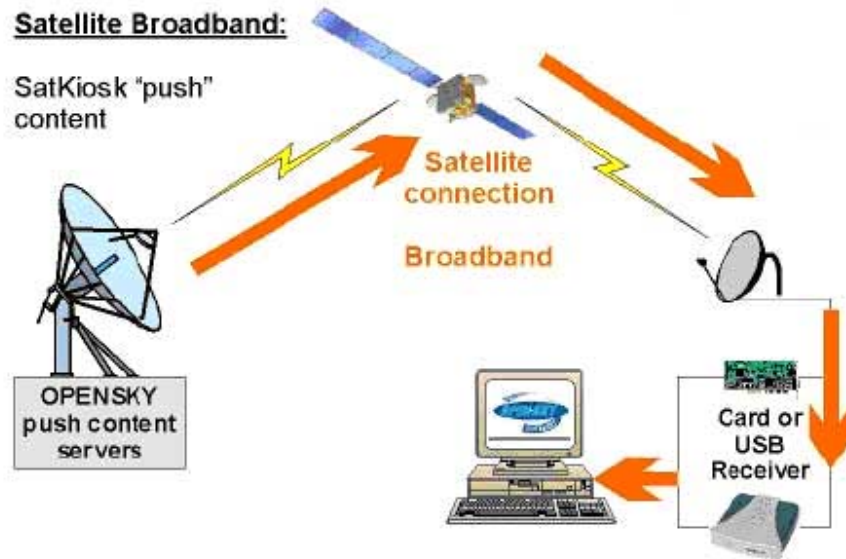


**Off-line reception of Gigabytes of content: websites, video, software and more.

Click and store – no need to use the phone line. Does not use up your monthly data
download allowance.**

Multicast Received Off-Line

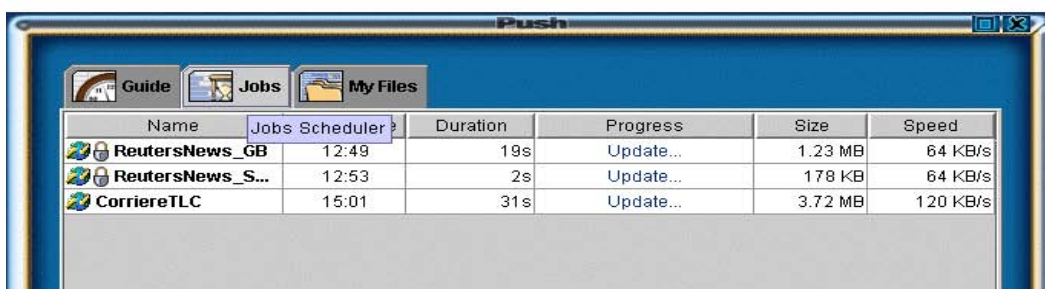
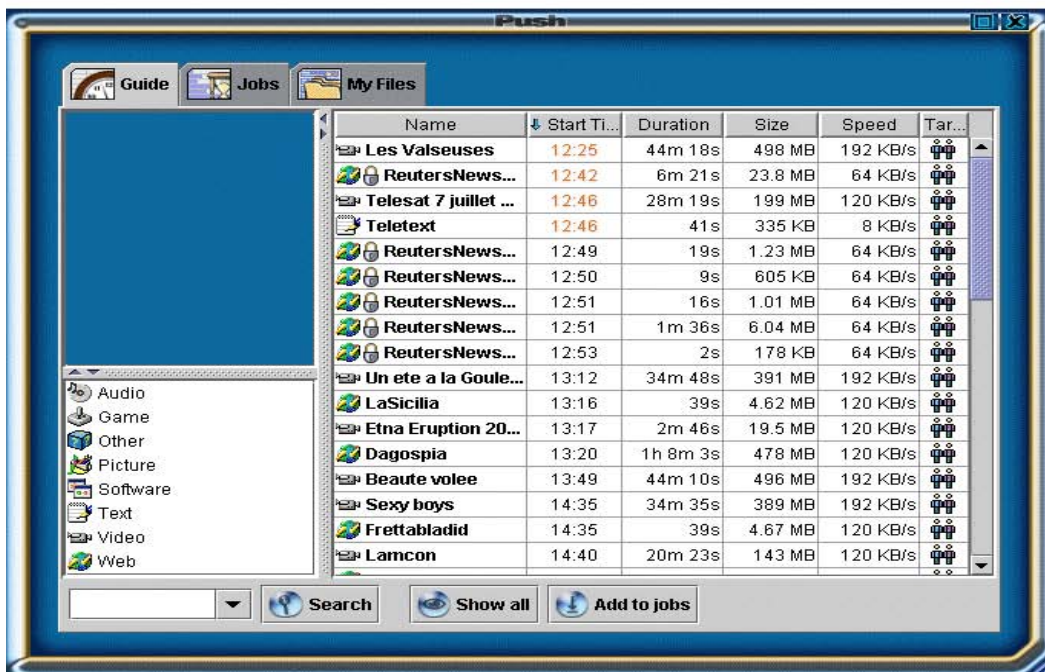


SatKiosk is a way of sending files to you over the satellite for storage on your hard drive. These files can be WebPages, videos, games, anything. You do not have to be online to receive these files. Just select them in the Guide and leave your data receiver and PC on with OSListener running. The files you select from the Guide will be stored on your PC the next time they are transmitted. Most content services are free There are subscription services like Reuters. There will be more added value subscription services in the future.

Settings > SatKiosk

Shows the folder for downloaded content (chosen during installation). SatKiosk will popup a notification when a selected file has been downloaded. The Guide shows you the files that are scheduled for transmission, the next scheduled transmission time and other details.

Double clicking on the file will add it to your Jobs list and allow you to select download and repair options. The Jobs page shows you the files you have chosen to save.



The My Files page shows you the files you have successfully downloaded and whether or not they need decompressing.

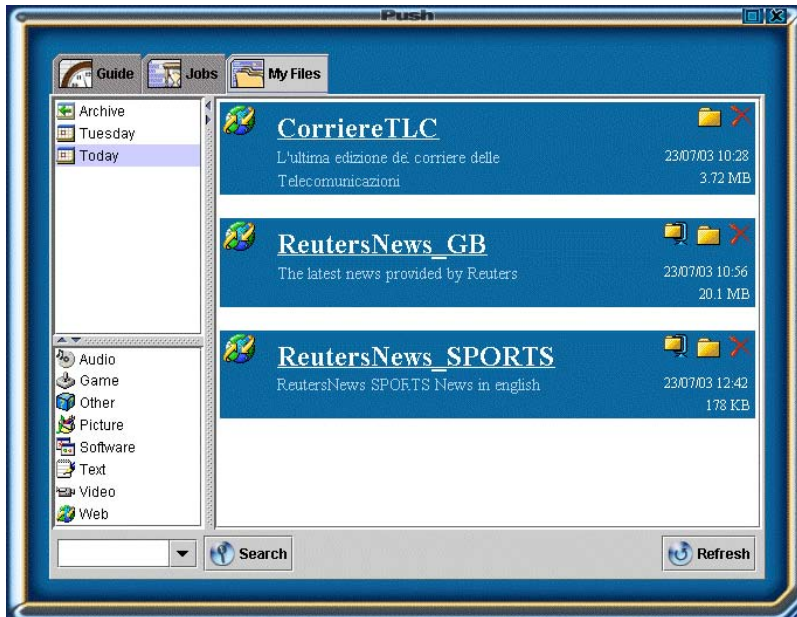
Click on the file title to launch it.

Click on the decompress icon to decompress it.

Click on the telephone icon to repair content terrestrially.

Click on the folder icon to view the folder.

Click on the red X to delete.



Corrupt data

Occasionally, files received will be reported as "Corrupted". This might be because you don't have enough free space on your hard drive. The push service can send you a very large amount of data so keep an eye on the files you have stored under the My Files page. A corrupt file can be corrected automatically at the next transmission. You can also repair it via a terrestrial connection. Adds Broadband to your existing terrestrial internet access.
